

27 April Nepal earthquake: JRC supports EU's response operations

In the aftermath of the powerful earthquake that struck Nepal on Saturday 25 April, the JRC is supporting the European Commission in coordinating the EU's response through up-to-date situation reports and maps.

27 April Continued positive outlook for crops

The latest Monitoring Agricultural Resources (MARS) bulletin, published today, finds that the weather conditions in most regions have been favourable for winter crop growth and spring sowings during the period of review (from 1 March to 20 April). Overall, the yield outlook is positive - close to, or somewhat above, the long-term average.

24 April JRC research contributes to two new standardised methods for testing contaminants in food

The European Committee for Standardization (CEN) released two European Standards to which JRC-IRMM contributed through validation of the methods.

23 April JRC wins competition on indoor localisation

A team of JRC researchers outperformed 27 teams from academia and industry across the globe and achieved best overall result at a competition on indoor localisation in Seattle, USA. Providing accurate position information on people and objects indoors, where GPS signals are not available, has been a challenging research topic over the last decade and there is not yet a large-scale commercial deployment in this field.

22 April Earth Day marks 25th anniversary

The Earth Day, celebrated on 22 April since 1970, is marked around the globe with initiatives and events on environmental protection. This week the JRC presents its work on soil, which is critical to life on Earth.

21 April Sex matters…even for liver cells

Female liver cells, and in particular those in menopaused women, are more susceptible to adverse effects of drugs than their male counterparts, according to new research carried out by the JRC.

21 April Foresight 2025: integrated and fast-evolving standards key to innovation

A JRC foresight study suggests the European standardisation system should accelerate and rely on an integrated strategy. The study argues this is the only way standardisation will be able to keep pace with technological developments and societal challenges, stimulating innovation and fostering competition.

21 April JRC developed accurate method for the analysis of 10 pesticides in soy beans

The Joint Research Centre (JRC) developed and in-house validated a precise method for the determination of 10 selected pesticides in soy beans.

20 April JRC produces first uranium reference materials certified for the production date for method validation

The JRC produced the first two uranium reference materials certified for the production date for validation of methods.

17 AprilReference materials for chemical analysis: JRC-IRMM co-editor of collection of publications in the journal Analytical and Bioanalytical Chemistry

A special paper collection addressing a number of the current challenges regarding "Reference Materials for Chemical Analysis" has been published by the peer-reviewed journal Analytical and Bioanalytical Chemistry under the guest editorship of Hendrik Emons and Stephen Wise.

17 April JRC-IRMM releases first reference material certified for nucleic acid mass concentration

JRC-IRMM developed and released the first certified reference material containing a defined DNA mass concentration that can be used to calibrate fluorescence-based assays for the quantification of nucleic acids in solution.

17 April Increasing nuclear security: knowing the date of production of uranium

To understand whether laboratories can accurately determine the date of the production of uranium, the Joint Research Centre (JRC) organised a proficiency test through its specific inter-laboratory comparison programme REIMEP. The outcome of this exercise confirmed the participating laboratories' capability to perform this type of measurement.

14 April JRC develops a novel technique for traceability of co-products from biofuel production used in animal nutrition

In the frame of the European project QSAFFE scientists from the JRC developed a rapid method based on infrared spectroscopy for the traceability of DDGS in terms of botanical and geographical origin.

13 April European Commission launches scientific debate on how to feed the planet

The European Commission has launched an online consultation on how science and innovation can help the EU ensuring safe, nutritious, sufficient and sustainable food globally.

10 AprilNew book entitled "Science, Philosophy and Sustainability: The End of the Cartesian dream"

JRC researchers have recently published a book entitled "Science, Philosophy and Sustainability: The End of the Cartesian dream".

9 April New multilingual resource for machine translation

The European Parliament (EP) and the JRC have jointly released a very large collection of documents and their translations. This rich resource can be used to improve Machine Translation software and other Language Technology applications. The 'Digital Corpus of the European Parliament' (DCEP) consists of EP texts produced between 2001 and 2012. It contains over 1.3 billion words in 24 languages, of text types as different as press releases, EP reports, questions to the EP and resulting answers, agendas, and more.

9 April Climate Models as Economic Guides: Scientific Challenge or Quixotic Quest?

A discussion paper by JRC researchers on economic and physical models of climate change is to appear in the Spring edition of Issues in Science and Technology.

9 April JRC releases its latest web based tool assessing the world's protected areas

DOPA Explorer 1.0 is the JRC's latest web-based interface which provides a simple way to explore nearly 16 000 of the world's protected areas.

8 April New governance proposed to enhance energy renovation in buildings

The JRC has recently launched a new report calling for a concerted effort to phase out inefficient buildings from the European building stock.

1 April Smart grids in Europe: outlook and large scale application

On 1 April 2015, the JRC released two reports in the area of smart grids, which look at how smart grids research and innovation can help achieve the Energy Union's targets of secure, sustainable, competitive and affordable energy.

1 April Towards a method for cytotoxicity screening of nanomaterials

The results of an inter-laboratory comparison study on a method for assessing the cytotoxicity of nanomaterials have been published. This is an important step towards a harmonised method for toxicity screening of nanomaterials.
